2. Meetings
 - a. Monthly during academic year.
 - b. May meet by email for discussions and votes
3. Decisions
 - a. Seek consensus
 - b. Majority vote rules
4. Responsibility 1: Review and approve new courses
 - a. Must first be approved by relevant degree program committee
 - b. Circulate to other program directors, program associate directors, Chief Administrative Officer, Assistant Director of Student Records & Enrollment
 - c. Vote (at meeting or by email), including suggestions for changes
 - d. Approved courses get a number and time
5. Responsibility 2: Review and approve new degree programs, including Dual and Joint degrees
 - a. Must first be approved by Dean and participating degree program committees
 - b. Circulate to other program directors, Chief Administrative Officer, Registrar
 - c. Vote (at meeting or by email), including suggestions for changes
 - d. Approved programs go to faculty for discussion and vote
 - e. Approved programs go to Grad Schools Council or Grad Professional Schools Council, Provost, and Trustees

6. Responsibility 3: Develop/revise/implement policies and procedures for the operation of academic programs. Current and in process policies include:
 - a. TA hiring
 - b. Compensation for teaching
 - c. Academic review
 - d. Other topics as appropriate

7. Serve as discussion and decision forum for other issues affecting academic Programs:
 - a. Discuss and design diversity, equity and inclusion initiatives
 - b. Coordination of international initiatives and issues
 - c. Listen to and discuss student views through student reps to the committee
 - d. Review and discuss program budgets
 - e. Student services (Admissions, career services, counseling, orientation, and other topics)
 - f. Others topics as appropriate.
