

The MPP in Social Policy & MBA in Nonprofit Management Dual Degree

THE MPP & MBA DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM

This intensive program requires six semesters (102 credits), including one summer. Students in the dual degree program are required to complete both the Team Consulting Project (TCP) and the MPP Capstone paper.

Students in the dual degree program may choose either track—beginning with the MPP curriculum or beginning with the MBA curriculum. In each case, dual-degree students must fulfill requirements for admission to both programs, including taking the GRE or the GMAT.

Application Requirements

- **Completed application form**
- **Curriculum Vitae (CV) or resume**
- **A detailed statement of purpose describing your career objectives and work experience**
- **A management problem analysis**
- **Three original letters of recommendation (at least one professional and one academic) on official letterhead sent directly to the Admissions Office from the recommenders. These letters must be accompanied by a Brandeis University Recommendation Form.**
- **Original or certified true copies of transcripts from all university-level studies, sent directly to the Admissions Office from each university. Transcripts in languages other than English must be accompanied by an official English translation.**
- **Official GRE or GMAT score report**
- **Official TOEFL or IELTS score report is required for all international applicants whose native language is not English.**
