## Honoring AmeriCorps Service with Full & Partial-Tuition Scholarships

AmeriCorps Alums, the premier leadership organization supporting AmeriCorps alumni world-wide has collaborated with the Heller School to offer the Heller School / AmeriCorps Alums National Service Scholarship Program. This program brings idealistic and committed leaders with a high level of maturity, insight and experience working in diverse settings together at the Heller School : The School of Choice for those who choose service.

Heller views AmeriCorps experience as a reliable indicator of high performance, commitment to social justice, leadership and teamwork. These are the attributes of successful graduate students, professionals and citizens.

All eligible applicants will receive a partial tuition scholarship according to this table. Additionally, one or more full-tuition scholarships will be awarded to eligible candidates annually. This is a tuition-only scholarship: fees, books, and other expenses will be the responsibility of the student.

One year of AmeriCorps service (\$10,000 + Segal award of \$5,350)	\$15,350 (\$3,837 per semester)
Two years of AmeriCorps service (\$10,000 + Segal award of \$10,700)	\$20,700 (\$5,175 per semester)
“Friends of AmeriCorps” staff employed for 1-4 years	\$10,000 (\$2,500 per semester)
“Friends of AmeriCorps” staff employed for 5 years	\$20,000 (\$5,000 per semester)

\* The Heller School/AmeriCorps Alums National Service scholarship award amounts include the Heller match of the Segal AmeriCorps Education Award for participating AmeriCorps staff and alumni.

### Applying for the National Service Scholarship

#### Candidates must submit:

- Completed Heller application for admission (see website for details)
- An additional essay discussing the importance of your AmeriCorps experience and how a Heller degree will contribute to a life of service given the AmeriCorps pledge of “I will carry this commitment with me this year and beyond!”

#### Deadlines and Notification

- Completed applications must be received no later than March 1
- Candidates will be notified of their admission to the Heller School after their application is processed
- The full-tuition National Service scholarship will be announced in April
- The maximum partial-tuition scholarship is \$20,700

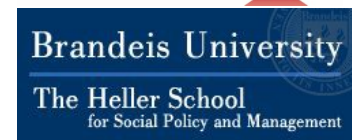

### Eligibility Requirements

- Admission to the Heller MBA or MPP degree program
- Alumni of a full-time AmeriCorps program or
- AmeriCorps employee with at least one year of full-time service
- Alumni of part-time programs are eligible for reduced scholarships
