



The Heller School and City Year give a year scholarship

Become a Heller School/City Year National Service Scholar

The Heller School for Social Policy and Management at Brandeis University and City Year have established a give a year partnership, highlighting the visions and values of both organizations integrating the power of knowledge and service in advancing social justice. This partnership will help bring idealistic and committed leaders with a high level of maturity, insight and experience working in diverse settings together at the Heller School: The School of Choice for those who choose service.

All eligible applicants will receive a partial tuition scholarship according to this table. Additionally, one or more full-tuition scholarships will be awarded to eligible candidates annually. This is a tuition-only scholarship: fees, books, and other expenses will be the responsibility of the student.

One year of City Year service (\$10,000 + Segal award of \$5,350)	\$15,350 (\$3,837 per semester)
Two years of City Year service (\$10,000 + Segal award of \$10,700)	\$20,700 (\$5,175 per semester)
“Friends of City Year” staff employed for 1-4 years	\$10,000 (\$2,500 per semester)
“Friends of City Year” staff employed for 5 years	\$20,000 (\$5,000 per semester)

* The Heller School/AmeriCorps Alums National Service scholarship award amounts include the Heller match of the Segal AmeriCorps Education Award for participating AmeriCorps staff and alumni.

Applying for the give a year Scholarship

Candidates must submit:

- Completed Heller application for admission (see website for details)
- An additional essay discussing the importance of your City Year experience and how a Heller degree will contribute to a life of service given the AmeriCorps pledge of “I will carry this commitment with me this year and beyond!”

Eligibility Requirements

- Admission to the Heller MPP or MBA degree program
- Alumni of City Year or
- City Year employee with at least one year of full-time service

Deadlines and Notification

- Completed applications must be received no later than March 1
- Candidates will be notified of their admission to the Heller School after their application is processed
- Scholarship recipients will be announced in April
- The maximum partial-tuition scholarship is \$20,700
