Applying for the StartingBloc Social Innovation Award

Candidates must:

- Complete Heller application for admission
- Indicate StartingBloc affiliation within application
- Application fees will be waived

Eligibility Requirements

- Admission to the Heller MPP or MBA degree program
- Alumni of StartingBloc program *or*
- StartingBloc employee with at least two years of full-time service

Deadlines and Notification

- Completed applications must be received no later than March 1 of the application year
- Candidates will be notified of their admission to the Heller School after their application is processed
