

ALTMAN ENDOWED FELLOWSHIP FOR HEALTH POLICY MANAGEMENT

The Altman Endowed Fellowship for Health Policy Management was established by Dr. Stuart and Mrs. Diane Altman and dozens of Dr. Altman's friends and colleagues on the occasion of his 25th Brandeis anniversary in 2003. It provides support for students pursuing Health Policy or Management degrees at the Masters or PhD level at the Heller School.

Dr. Altman is an internationally recognized economist whose expertise lies in healthcare economics and policy, healthcare industry reform and Medicare. He has worked as a senior advisor for six U.S. Presidents. He has served as Deputy Assistant Secretary of the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare; the Chair of the Prospective Payment Assessment Commission; and a member of the National Bipartisan Commission on the Future of Medicare. In 2012, Governor Duval Patrick appointed Dr. Altman as chair of the Massachusetts' Health Policy Commission. He has authored and co-authored numerous books and journal articles. Dr. Altman was dean of the Heller School from 1977-1993 and then again from 2005-2008. In 1990-1991, he was Interim President of Brandeis.
