

JACK TEIGH BLUME AND ABBY BLUME BROWN, PHD'72, SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT



Created in 1999, the Jack Teigh Blume and Abby Blume Brown, PhD'72, Scholarship Endowment was established to support graduate students enrolled at the Heller School for Social Policy and Management. The intent of the scholarship is to support individuals who are planning management or service careers in community-based, human service organizations.

The scholarship is named after alumna Abby Blume Brown, PhD'72, and her father, Jack. Abby worked in the mental health field for many years before moving to New York in the early 1990s to attend the Robert De Niro Film School and become a documentary film maker. Film project topics have included American women spies and the history of black nurses in America.
