The Marjorie S. Trotter Doctoral Fellowship was created in 2014 by Jonathan G. '75 and Margot Trotter Davis, PhD'08. The fund is intended to provide stipend assistance to select fourth year PhD students at the Heller School of Social Policy & Management conducting rigorous research required to complete their doctoral dissertations.

Margot Trotter Davis, PhD'08, has been involved in the field of addictions as both a researcher and clinician for over 35 years. Margot received her PhD from Heller in 2008. She also has a master's degree in Social Work from Boston College. In addition to her work as a Senior Research Associate at the Schneider Institutes at the Heller School, she maintains a private practice with a specialty in substance abuse.
