

Chris Jennings is an over three decades-long health policy veteran of the White House, the Congress and the private sector. Mr. Jennings is President of Jennings Policy Strategies, a nationally respected health care consulting firm committed to assisting foundations and other aligned stakeholders develop policies to ensure higher quality, more affordable health care. In January 2014, Mr. Jennings departed from the White House where he served as Senior Advisor to the President for Health Policy. He served in a similar capacity in the Clinton White House for eight years. From his positions, Mr. Jennings helped pass, enact and implement the Affordable Care Act, the Children's Health Insurance Program and numerous other health reforms. In his decade of service in the U.S. Senate, he served as the Deputy Director of the Special Committee on Aging for three Senators (including his home state Senator, John Glenn) and led major health reform efforts. Outside of government service, Mr. Jennings has been a senior health policy advisor to ten Presidential campaigns, the 2008, 2016 and 2020 Democratic Platform Drafting Committees, and multiple gubernatorial and Senate candidates. Most recently, Vice President Biden appointed Mr. Jennings to represent President-Elect Biden on the Biden-Sanders Unity Task Force.
