Millions of Americans with disabilities need Medicaid so they can receive needed services and supports.

Over 7.8 million people with disabilities rely on Medicaid-funded Home and Community Based Services (HCBS), such as home health care and personal care, and habilitation services. Another approximately 1.5 million, including 6 in 10 nursing facility residents, rely on Medicaid for institutional long term services and supports (LTSS).*

> Medicaid helps around 9.3 million disabled people afford services and supports they require.

Over 1.5 million disabled people are able to afford **long-term services and supports** in institutions such as nursing homes because of Medicaid.
