Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) that millions of Americans with disabilities require to live are considered "optional services."

HCBS are "optional services" that states may provide through Medicaid, but do not have to. This means that if states face budget crunches, these services will be among the first cut. Optional services include personal care, respite, family support, supported employment.*

States facing budgetary challenges may opt to cut HCBS that disabled people rely on *first*.
